The Mississippi School of the Arts (MSA) is seeking applicants for the position of Visual Arts teacher at the Mississippi School of the Arts (MSA); a statewide residential school that provides academic education and advanced programs of study in vocal music, theatre, visual arts, dance, media arts, and literary arts. The Mississippi School of the Arts is located on the historic Whitworth College Campus in Brookhaven, Mississippi, which is approximately 60 miles south of Jackson, the state capital.

Teachers at the Mississippi School of the Arts work under direct supervision of the Principal. This position encompasses duties that include, but are not limited to, planning, producing, implementing, and evaluating comprehensive, standards-based curriculum, instruction, and assessments, monitoring student progress; sponsoring student events and competitions; recruiting students; collaborating with student life personnel to ensure a positive learning experience within a residential environment; and other assigned duties and services that are necessary to ensure the success of the Mississippi School of the Arts.

The successful candidate should have:

- Experience in planning, producing, implementing, and evaluating comprehensive, standards-based curriculum, instruction, and assessments in history;
- Excellent written and oral communication;
- Up-to-date knowledge of emerging trends and issues in education;
- Experience in collaboration with teachers in other content areas;
- Up-to-date multimedia technology skills;
- Active involvement as a professional in the content area;
- Experience in high school setting preferred;
- Prior knowledge of the policies and procedures of the State of Mississippi preferred; and
- National Board Certification will be considered a plus.

A Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university in the subject area to be taught,
Certification as required below, AND
Five (5) year of experience related to the duties described above.

Certification:

Possession of or qualify for a valid Mississippi A (Bachelor's), AA (Master's), AAA (Specialist's), or AAAA (Doctoral) teaching certification in the subject area to be taught. Certification must be confirmed prior to hire.
