

How to Make a Short Film/Scene

- Decide on your main character. Who are they? What are their goals?
 - Invent an engaging scenario or short story for your character.
 - Decide where to put the camera to capture the most important moments in the story.
 - Ensure that your story has a clear beginning, middle, and end that a viewer can follow and understand.
- *Be sure to put your imagination and creativity on display. Tell us a story. That's what we want to see!**



How Not to Make a Short Film/Scene

- Don't simply sit in front of the camera and talk.
- Don't follow a person around like a news reporter asking questions.
- Don't use a lot of shaky camera work.
- Avoid clichéd and triggering subjects such as suicide or depression.
